1. Introduction

When we say to our kids “You’re Grounded!”, we have to back that up with enforcement. But if you don’t jot down a note of when you grounded your child and how long the grounding is supposed to last, it’s easy to lose track. And if you have more than one child, this can become particularly difficult.

Grounded! from Raging Fjord allows you to keep track of when each of your kids is grounded, the reason for the grounding, and the duration. If you decide to “pardon” the child from the grounding early, the application keeps track of when you do that and why.

Particularly useful is that you can see a history of all the times the child has been grounded and pardoned.

Updates

Grounded! is an application for use on the iPhone and iPod touch. It is available from the Apple iTunes Application Store. Use your iTunes to check back periodically for updates, as the Application Store will automatically update your applications.

2. The Kids List

The first step in using Grounded! is to add your kids to the Kids list. In addition to the kids' names, this shows information about the most recent grounding.

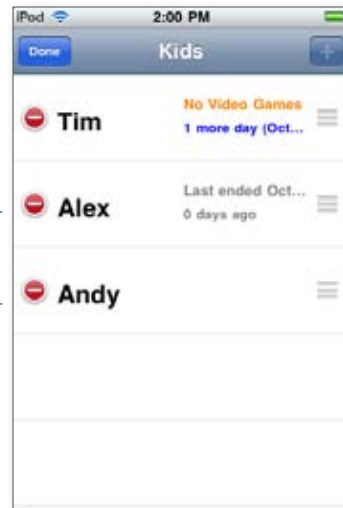
Add Kids:

Tap the '+' button to add a kid to the list, then enter his or her name.

Edit Kids List

If you need to make any changes, tap the "Edit" button. You can then tap the red "⊖" button to remove someone from the list, tap the name to edit it, or drag the "☰" handle to rearrange the order of the list.

Note: If you delete a kid from the list, this permanently deletes all of the information about that kid, including current and historical grounding info.



3. Individual Kid's Screen

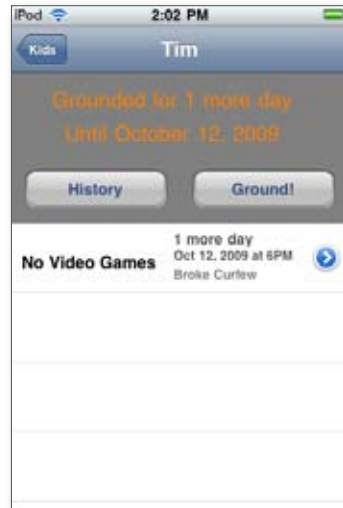
All the action in Grounded! takes place from each kid's individual screen. If and when you ground your kid, log it in the Grounded! system. Start by tapping on a name to access the individual kid's screen.

Current Grounding

If your kid is currently grounded, the time left in the grounding as well as the date and time that the grounding will be over are listed in orange letters at the top of the screen. The details of the grounding are listed on the screen below the buttons. It will show the punishment followed by how much more time is left in the grounding, the date and time the grounding will be over, and the reason for the grounding. Tap on the row here to bring up the adjustment screen for an existing grounding. Click on the "▶" button to see a summary of the grounding.

History

Tap the "History" button to see the history of every time this kid has been grounded or pardoned. The list shows the reason for the event, the date it occurred, and the duration. Any grounding that is still currently active will be shown in orange text. Click on the punishment description to go to the Adjust screen. In the History screen, tapping a row will take you to the screen with details for that grounding.



Adjust Screen

Go to the Adjust screen to add or subtract time from the current grounding and indicate a reason for the change. You can also tap the "Pardon" button to end the grounding. If you Pardon, then the list of reasons will change to the reasons for a Pardon.



Ground!

Tap the "Ground!" button to log information on the "New Grounding" screen.

First indicate the duration of the grounding. Use the slider or tap the "+" or "-" buttons to set the number of days, then tap the appropriate time button.

Next use the left wheel to select the punishment, such as "No TV," etc. If the correct punishment is not listed, then tap the "Edit Punishments" button to add a new one.

Finally, use the right wheel to select the reason for the grounding, such as "Broke Curfew," etc. If the correct reason is not listed, then tap the "Edit Reasons" button to add a new one. Tap the "Done" button when you are finished.
